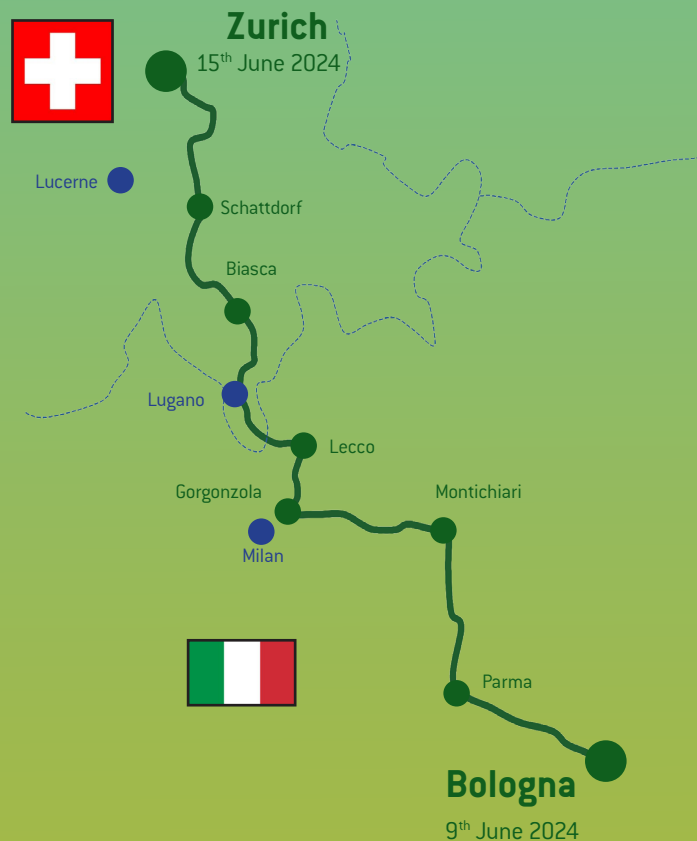

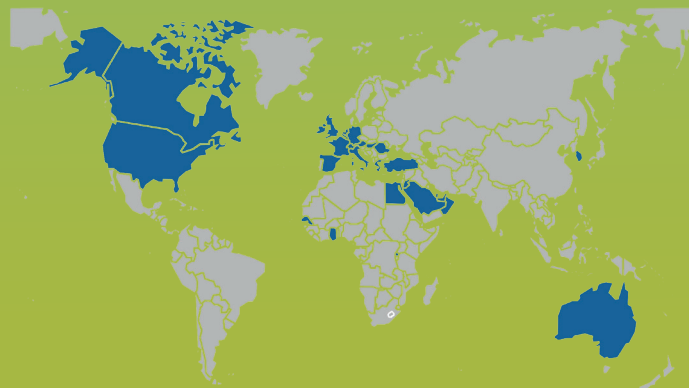
PARTICIPANTS
